

Signs from Peekaboo Moon



Moon



MOON
The index finger and thumb open and close as the hand moves down and round in shape of crescent moon. Also means LUNAR.



Star



STAR
Middle fingertip flicks off thumb several times at head height. *Varies.*



Clock



CLOCK, TIME
Extended R. index finger waggles forward/down against the L. palm. Short repeated downward ticking motion gives SECONDS.



House



HOME
Tips of flat hands touch, with hands held at an angle.



Flower



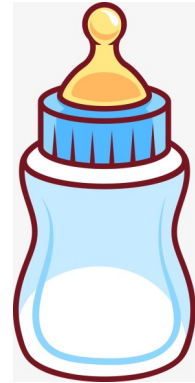
'O' hand (or bunched or Irish 'T' hand) moves from side to side under the nose as if sniffing a flower. Also GARDEN (regional).



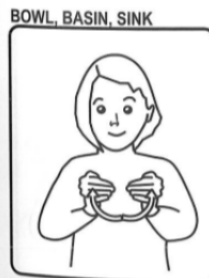
Bottle



Closed hand with thumb out tips upwards near the mouth.



Bowl



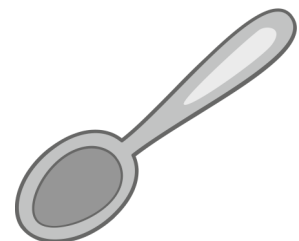
Palm up cupped hands held together, move apart and twist to palm facing in outline shape.



Spoon



(CEREAL) Irish 'T' hand makes spooning actions up to the mouth. Also means CEREAL, PUDDING, SWEET and one version of SOUP.



Cat



Fingers flex as hands make short repeated outward movements from sides of mouth. *Varies.*



Mouse

MOUSE, MICE



Tip of index finger on side of nose; hand makes quick twisting movements from wrist. A single twist is *regional* sign for PIG.



Light

LIGHT, LAMP



Full 'O' hand (both for plural) springs down/open (LIGHT ON) or closes (LIGHT OFF). Can be *located* to suit context.

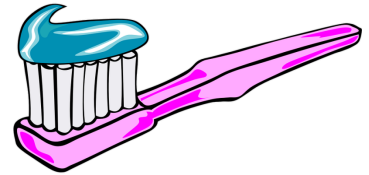


Toothbrush

TOOTHBRUSH



Irish 'T' hand (or straight index finger) moves up and down (or side to side) near the mouth. Also means CLEAN (DO) ONE'S TEETH.



Bath

BATH, TOWEL



Closed hands move in action of holding and drying with a bath towel.

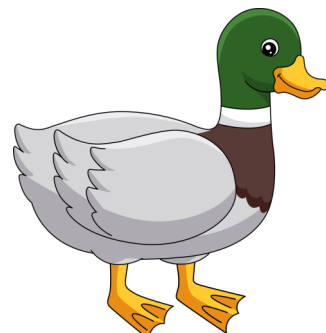


Duck

DUCK, GOOSE



Fingers of bent hand (or 'N' hand) open and close onto thumb several times in front of chin.



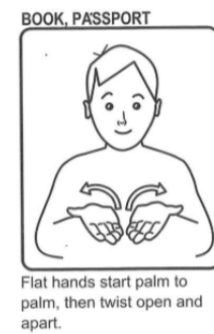
